  - New Business
    - PAPA Plan Survey  
Dan Baisden came to speak with everyone about the importance of this survey. The last one was completed in 2005. A lot changes in 15 years. He noted that 25 WWP neighbors have already completed the survey. He said he hopes we can have 50 completed by the deadline of September 7th.
    - S Harrison Traffic Calming  
Meredith Stumpf has been petitioning the City of Fort Wayne for speed signs. Harrison is getting first priority due to the amount of accidents. Also looking at 4 way stop signs for interior streets. The City is not fans of street art, but we are watching what HoMa does this weekend with street art to see how the City will react before we start our street painting project.
    - Fall Cleanup  
Will be held on September 19th this year from 8am to Noon. Same day as the Great American Cleanup. Not sure if we will have a dumpster or garbage truck yet. Normal rules apply: no chemicals, electronics, wet paint, etc. The association will buy lawn packs again and Terri Stumpf will host them on her porch for neighbors to pick up.

9 HIP grants received. About \$500 left to be granted. 2 SIP grants received. About \$1600 left to be granted. For ALL In: Sarah Stegenga brought a solar security light to show at the meeting. Hours worked in the alleys during the

neighborhood cleanup will count. Sarah will bring a few lights with her to pass out to neighbors who complete their hours during the cleanup.

- **Holiday Home Tour**

This is our biggest fundraiser of the year. It will be a virtual tour this year. 10 homes have already committed to participating. (Question brought up about videography or photography of the homes - HHT Committee still working on) Kick off weekend is December 5th and 6th. There will be carolers, carriage rides, food trucks. There will also be a scavenger hunt. No ticket price this year, but we are asking for donations. A percentage of the donations will go to a local community non-profit. This year it is super important to get sponsors. We are offering 4 different levels of sponsorship: \$1,000, \$500, \$250, \$100 with differing perks for each level. There will be a meeting soon for all the homeowners committing to the 2020 tour.
