May 26th, 2020 - 40 people attended - held outside on Pete's lot

- Business Meeting
 - Secretary's Report - last two meetings cancelled. February was chili cook-off and officer elections.
 - Treasurer's Report - Goal of 70 dues paid members. We have 39 so far.
 - New Business
 - Fence Policy - Discussion held with neighbors. Some said it's hard to regulate for everyone and might be better on a case by case basis. Suggestions for fences higher than 6ft when up against commercial properties. Talked about listing shrubs as 'living fences'. Charlie will repost the survey monkey about the fence policy with some additional questions. Neighborhood will revisit in June.
 - Water Warriors - Looks like we are covered, but won't turn away any extra help if offered. Neighborhood thanked Templo for hosting the cart this year. Lyndsay will print map with planter locations for the volunteers.
 - Old Business
 - INN Grant Money - no update available to share with neighbors. COVID-19 paused the SWAP meetings.
 - Ice Cream Social - 2-4pm on June 7th at Templo. No fire truck this year. Will provide pre-packaged treats and keep socially distanced. Talked about having chalk paint and bubbles/wands for the kids.
 - Tire & TV Days - this is HoMa's only fundraiser. Charlie and Eddie can pick up for neighbors. Talk of setting up a donation site and making a Facebook post about it.
 - Tox Away Days - Information for neighborhood in the May newsletter. Not something we are collecting as a neighborhood because you have to pay to turn in the toxic materials.
 - Voting on June 2nd - Josh Summers encouraged neighbors to vote 'Yes' for FWCS.
