ASSOCIATION MEETING MINUTES

September 29th, 2020

- Business Meeting
 - Secretary's Report - See August Minutes
 - Treasurer's Report -
46 paid members and a balance of \$24,471.90. Recent transactions include HHT ad income and paying out HIP and SIP grants.
 - New Business
 - Out of a Jam -
Bernie and Paula Kaufman spoke about their nonprofit *Out of a Jam* and how they help women and youth in the community. They are hosting an online auction/fundraiser at the beginning of October. Out of a Jam is starting a food rescue program and have plans for a spaghetti dinner to feed the neighborhood across from Miss Virginia's Food Pantry. Paula would also like to see WWPN reinstate our community garden. Talk was also brought up about hosting gardening lessons for neighbors who are interested in planting their own gardens. A small discussion about how to water the community garden also took place.
 - Packard Park Plans
There will be a vote held on October 14th for the future of Packard Park. They want to remove the ball diamond, build an amphitheater, and have more green space to better serve the community the park is located in.
 - Celebration of Life
On October 10th there will be a celebration of life held for Patricia Knaebe. Patricia's husband Bill will be throwing quite the party. It starts at 3pm and will last until the party is over. There are plans to create a Facebook event to help spread the word.
 - Old Business
 - HIP, SIP, and ALL In
HIP = we have received 9 grant applications and are still waiting to pay out a couple of those. There is \$509.00 still in the budget.
SIP = we have received 5 grant applications and are still waiting to pay out one of those. There is still \$898.00 still in the budget.
ALL In - Per Charlie, Sarah S. said she has given away 8 solar powered lights. If you need help filling out the form, please contact Sarah.

- **Holiday Home Tour Update**
Sponsorships are still needed. We have \$2,112.50 committed so far. There is a link on our neighborhood website for anyone who wants to be a sponsor. Still looking at quotes for video recordings of the homes.
 - **INN Grant**
It would be nice if WWPN could use some of this money from one of the street tree proposals to replace some of the trees we recently lost in the neighborhood.
 - **PAPA Survey**
698 surveys were completed. 45 of those were in Spanish and 53 came from WWPN.

- **Additional Comments/Announcements**
 - Craig reported lots of activity at 2420 Hoagland. Lyndsay said there is behind the scenes stuff being done on this issue. Neighbors need to call in issues if they see it.
 - October 4th is the pumpkin sale for the Fairfield Neighborhood Fundraiser. They are also planning on a pumpkin carving contest. WWPN will possibly purchase one of their prizes to give away.
 - Should we do another Dumpster Day in October? Dumpster is free for the neighborhood to use. Charlie said we can do a poll on Facebook to see if there is interest.
