WWPN Association Meeting Minutes

October 29th, 2019

- Lee Golani gave a brief presentation on ASPIN - a medical insurance option for the uninsured.
- Guest Speaker

- Business Meeting
 - Secretary's Report
 - Treasurer's Report - 61 members; \$23,348.96 balance
 - Standing Committees
 - Holiday Home Tour (December 7th & 8th)
 - Volunteers Needed
 - Leaf Pickup Nov 18th - if more leaves fall after the city's pickup, please help rake and bag - especially at HHT locations
 - Old Business
 - New Business
 - Neighborhood Safety
 - Alley Lights - Sarah is gathering signatures on petitions in order to add alley lighting - city pays 100%
 - Safety Committee - we need a few volunteers to prioritize safety concerns and decide allocation of non-matching grant funds
 - Security discussion - The RING company (security cameras) will work cooperatively with FWRPD and Sheriff's office
 - Reminder - Call the Desk Sergeant or 911 (if emergency) for any suspicious behavior. If you hear gunshots, even if you are not sure how many or which direction, please call it in. The police map all the calls in order to pinpoint the location - the more calls the better.
 - Grant - A portion of Grants will be non-matching and disbursed for use by homeowners on security upgrades (examples: exterior motion lighting, security cameras, electrician to wire lighting, etc.)
 - PAPA Retreat - 11/9 - the neighborhood can send up to 4 people
 - 2020 Budget preview
 - A question was asked about the \$500,000 grant through SWAP and if it impacts our budget. Answer: they are separate.

- A question was asked about increasing dues amount. Lyndsay reiterated the purpose of WWPNA dues is not to raise funds - thankfully, HHT provides income. Rather, dues are a means of encouraging participation
